

COURSE DESCRIPTION (SACS)

VEM 5206 Advanced Clinical Behavior - 1 credit. This course will review presenting signs, history and treatment of common problems in animal behavior. These include: canine aggression; canine anxiety, fears and phobias; canine barking, roaming and elimination; attention seeking behavior; canine acral lick dermatitis; obsessive compulsive disorders; feline psychogenic alopecia; feline elimination disorders; feline scratching, vocalizing and aggression. Also included will be a discussion on puppy and kitten training and the use of psychoactive drugs in behavior disorders. Course Coordinator - Dr. T. Curtis; Grading System - Letter grade.
