

COURSE DESCRIPTION (SACS)

VEM 5307 Small Animal Dermatology - 2 credits. Advanced topics in small animal dermatology including recurrent canine pyoderma, management of dermatophytosis, allergies, autoimmune skin diseases, immunosuppressive drugs, nodular skin diseases, pruritus, otitis externa, cutaneous manifestations of systemic disease, feline dermatology, and genodermatoses. This course is a mixture of didactic lectures and case based discussions. Students should note that "VEM 5769 Dermatology Clerkship" is considered a pre-requisite for this didactic course. Although the instructor will permit student enrollment without having completed the pre-requisite VEM 5769 clerkship, prior completion of VEM 5769 is **STRONGLY ENCOURAGED**.
